Judit Acsády PhD is a Senior Research Fellow at the Research Department for Families and Social Relations at the Institute for Sociology at the Centre for Social Sciences with experience in gender studies, social history and qualitative research.

Dr Acsády has special interest in social movements, feminism, processes of women's emancipation, gender relations before and after the transitions in Eastern Europe and the questions of gender and climate change. She developed a new approach to first wave feminism in Hungary, pointing at the social networks of women's organizations and the way feminists contributed to social change and innovation (including values, institutions, social care, etc.).
